Opening Times

Juniors meet 1915hrs-2030hrs with entry via the main entrance to the church and exit via the fire doors. The main doors are opened at 1900hrs.

Company and Seniors meet 1915hrs-2100hrs, entry is via the main entrance and exit is via the fire doors, as with Juniors the main doors are opened at 1900hrs.
